1. Welcome and Open Meeting
A quorum was present. The meeting began at 4:05 p.m.
2. Approval of August and October 2011 Minutes

A motion was made by Cindy Jameson and seconded by Lounell Britt to:

The motion passed unanimously.

3. Report: Lindsay Carson presented

The governor's office of appointments provided clarification regarding gubernatorial appointees and terms of service. Upon case law review, it was discovered that gubernatorial appointees may in fact serve three, rather than two, terms. Mike Pachik has reapplied and there has been one other applicant, not known to ELC, but personally recommended by County Commissioner Latvala. Cindy Jameson can reapply for a third term if she wishes to; her term is up in August 2012.
4. Provider Representative Recruitment
Diane Brown (faith based provider representative) and Judith Miller-Bruckner (for-profit provider representative) will both term out in January 2012. To date, two faith based provider applications have been received. Recruitment for a for-profit provider representative must be priority. ELC has reached out to the Early Childhood Association to add in recruitment for this position.
5. Private Sector Recruitment Event:
Cindy Seletos and Lindsay Carson presented.

The board recruitment event on October 25th was successful. Attendees: Mike Pachik, Cindy Seletos, Shurrea Daniels (current board members); Julie Jansen, former superintendent of schools, now working in private sector; Laura Hunt, sales representative with Achieve2000; Connie Mamaro, board chair of Head Start; and Kandy Pinkstaff, board chair of Clearwater/Dunedin Jr. League and private sector businessperson. An overview of services was presented by Lindsay and both a promotional and information powerpoint presentation was made. Cindy recommended a repeat of the event with more participation by other board members to increase the guest list and pool of potential representatives.

6. **JWB Representative**
JWB is reelecting officers and have several new gubernatorial appointees; Martha Lenderman was not re-appointed. Her replacement on the ELC board should be announced November 10, 2011 by JWB.
7. **Pinellas County Schools Representative**
Kathleen Young is the new designee from Pinellas County Schools. She has already met with Lindsay for Board Orientation and will begin serving on the Board at the next board meeting. Ms. Young has worked as the principal of an elementary school and is currently Director of Elementary Education for Pinellas County Schools.
8. **Board Member Applications**
A number of applications for private sector and faith based child care center representatives have been received by the ELC office. Additionally, there is active recruitment efforts for applications for the private sector child care center representative position, and more applications are expected to be received in the near future. Ellen Lasher, Committee Chair, stated "because I am terming out in January 2012, I think I shouldn't be making decisions regarding future members of the board."
This agenda item was tabled for the next Board Development meeting to allow for time to compile additional applications received, and to acknowledge Committee Chair Lasher's concerns as expressed. A new chair needs to be appointed to the Board Development Committee.
Discussion: Lindsay Carson will check the by-laws to determine if residence in Pinellas County is part of the criteria for ELC board membership.

9. Board Member – Jeff Joyner
Jeff Joyner's first term expires November 2011. He has been appointed as ELC Treasurer by Chair Peluso; however, his second term does need to be formally appointed and approved by the board.




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
