GENERAL WORKSHOP INFORMATION

Check-in begins thirty (30) minutes prior to the workshop. Workshops will begin and end on time. Come prepared with paper and pens/pencils for note-taking.

Limited Seating

In compliance with fire and safety regulations, registrations can not exceed room capacity. Most workshops have limited seating and quickly reach capacity.

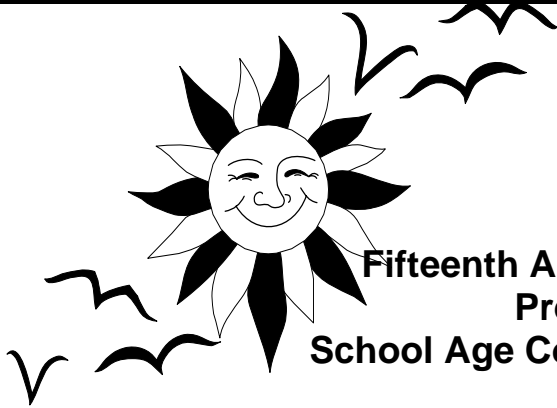
