GENERAL TRAINING INFORMATION

Training Check In

Check-in begins thirty (30) minutes prior to the training. Trainings will begin and end on time. There will be **no admittance** to the training **10 minutes past the start time**. Come prepared with paper and pens/pencils for note-taking.

Limited Seating

In compliance with fire and safety regulations, registrations can not exceed room capacity. Most training has limited seating and quickly reaches capacity.

Registration

On-line registration is required for all trainings. Only register for trainings you will attend. Early registration is recommended. You will receive two e-mails, the first one is a Registration Request and the second one is a Registration Confirmation. Registration is not complete until you receive the Registration Confirmation e-mail. If the training fills to capacity, you will receive a notice by email, that the session is full. Should space become available, you may try to register at a later date.

Payment

Payment for Early Learning Coalition of Pinellas County, Inc. trainings are made at the time of on-line registration unless noted. Payment for CEU's may also be done at this time. All payments are non-refundable unless cancellation of registration is received by the Professional Development Department five (5) business days before the scheduled training. It is your responsibility to contact the Professional Development department by telephone at (727-548-1439 ext.235) should you need to cancel your registration.

Training Cancellation

Should training be cancelled, participants will be contacted and registration and CEU fees (if applicable) will be refunded.

Mandatory Reporting – A Community Responsibility for Child Protection (See Area 1 – Health, Safety & Nutrition) – This training will provide an enhanced clarification about child protection investigation procedures and incorporate the Florida Statute 39 that governs action. Participants will become familiar with the twenty maltreatments of abuse for reporting concerns. The decision making tool, an allegation matrix for investigation, will be observed and practice scenarios will be utilized to determine which maltreatment are most appropriate. The participants will be able to identify best practice for reporting child abuse and guidance on the various types of reports generated. Information about child on child sexual abuse reports will be discussed. They will explore the five protective factors and learn about critical risk factors.

- Identify the twenty maltreatments for child abuse.
- Enhance understanding of appropriate reports for child abuse.
- Describe procedures and policy of child abuse investigations.
- Gain confidence in generating child abuse reports with a better knowledge base about child protection.

THE EARLY LEARNING COALITION

Social Emotional Development of Infants and Toddlers (See Area 2 – Child Development and Learning) – This training will review typical social and emotional development of infants and toddlers. It will focus on the three temperament types as proposed by the New York Longitudinal Study and the first two stages of psychosocial development as theorized by Erik Erikson. Participants will do a self-exploration to gain insight on their temperament and how it affects their interactions with young children. Participants will also learn about responsive caregiving. They will also practice understanding non-verbal communication in order to better understand the infants or toddlers in their care.

Learning Outcomes

The learner will:

- Gain an understanding of the history of childhood and current issues in childhood.
- Identify the three temperament types as reported by the New York Longitudinal Study.
- Connect identified temperament types with learner's own temperament.
- Connect insight on self-identified temperament and interactions with infants and toddlers temperaments.
- Identify psychosocial stages of development in infants and toddlers as identified by Erik Erikson.
